Day 2**Pleiku City Exploration & Cultural Insights***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Pleiku*

The morning begins with a guided tour of Pleiku's significant sites after breakfast. The first stop is T'Nung Lake, a tranquil body of water formed within an ancient volcanic crater, often referred to as the "eye of the highlands." Following this, the journey continues to Dektu and Dekrol villages, home to the Banar community, where the impressive Rong House, a traditional communal structure, stands as a symbol of their culture. Visitors will also explore a Banar cemetery, observing unique wooden statues and jars that mark ancestral resting places. A highlight is a soulful Gong performance, reflecting the region's deep spiritual connection.

In the afternoon, after a traditional local lunch, the tour proceeds to the Gia Lai Museum of Ethnology, offering insights into the lives and traditions of the Bahnar and Jarai ethnic groups through various artifacts. A visit to the Pleiku former prison provides a moment for reflection on historical resilience. Spiritual serenity can be found at Minh Thanh Pagoda, a site of Buddhist architectural elegance, followed by a stop at the graceful Immaculate Conception Cathedral. The day concludes with a stroll through a bustling local market, rich with mountain herbs and local produce, before returning to the hotel.

The first destination is Nha Rong in Plei Don Village, another magnificent communal house serving as the heart of the Banar community, where gatherings for festivals and prayers take place. Next, explore the serene Bishop's House of Kontum, a charming wooden retreat that showcases the blend of French missionary influence and Central Highlands traditions.

The journey continues to Chu Dang Ya Volcano, a dormant volcano revered as a sacred protector of the land. Visitors can walk upon its fertile soil, experiencing the earth's gentle breath and allowing the mountain breeze to bring a sense of calm. This site offers a unique connection to the natural and spiritual landscape of the region. The day concludes with the return to Pleiku, leaving travelers with a profound appreciation for Kon Tum's quiet beauty and cultural depth.

Day 4

Overland Journey to Buon Ma Thuot

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Buon Me Thuat

Following a leisurely breakfast in Pleiku, embark on an overland transfer to Buon Ma Thuot. This approximately 3.5-hour drive showcases the raw, natural splendor of the Central Highlands. The route traverses landscapes characterized by rich red basalt soil, which nurtures extensive coffee plantations and verdant forests. As the journey progresses towards Buon Ma Thuot, the air noticeably warms, and the scenery opens up, welcoming travelers to Vietnam's renowned coffee capital. Upon arrival, check into the hotel, with the rest of the day free for personal relaxation or independent exploration of the surrounding area.

Yok Don National Park & Don Village Elephant Encounter

The morning begins with a pickup from Buon Ma Thuot City for a one-hour drive to Don Village and Yok Don National Park. The exploration starts with a visit to a traditional Ede longhouse and a walk across a bamboo bridge spanning the Serepok River. A stop at the Tomb of the Elephant King, a legendary figure in elephant training, offers historical insights, along with visits to two elephant graves and stories of these majestic animals. A short walk through Don Village reveals its multicultural character, including a visit to the house of Amakong, a renowned elephant trainer and herbal healer, known for its Lao-style architecture and local narratives. Opportunities for ethnic snacks, local fruits, and souvenirs are available. Afterward, enjoy a local lunch or participate in a three-hour traditional cooking class with an Ede family in Jang Lanh Village, preparing and sharing a meal in a heartwarming setting.

In the afternoon, from 13:30 to 16:30, the focus shifts to observing elephants living freely within Yok Don National Park. These elephants, previously involved in tourism, are now cared for in their natural environment. The guide will provide information on local medicinal plants and the distinct personalities of each elephant. The day concludes at 16:30 with the return to Buon Ma Thuot City, leaving visitors with a profound sense of connection to the land, its people, and its wildlife.

Coffee Culture & Waterfall Wonders of Buon Ma Thuot

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Buon Me Thuat

At 08:30, depart with a guide and driver to visit the impressive D'ray Nur and D'ray Sap waterfalls. Enjoy a peaceful hour-long walk amidst nature, feeling the cool mist and having the option for a refreshing swim. Following the waterfalls, the tour visits Kuop Village, an Ede community, where travelers can learn about their unique matriarchal traditions and observe daily life in the highlands. En route, a stop at a local coffee plantation and factory provides insight into coffee cultivation and processing. A delicious lunch will be served at a local restaurant.

The afternoon continues with a visit to Kotam Village, featuring a special Weasel Coffee Farm and the Trung Nguyen Coffee Village. Here, guests can attend a coffee show, learn brewing techniques, and visit a local coffee shop. The day concludes with a stop at the Buon Ma Thuot Central Market before returning to the hotel.
