Day 2

Hanoi's Historical & Cultural Landmarks

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi

The tour commences at the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's inaugural national university, which dates back to the 11th century and served as a center for Confucian scholarship. Next, you will visit the distinctive One Pillar Pagoda, a Buddhist structure famously resembling a lotus flower, symbolizing purity.

The journey continues to the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, a significant national monument dedicated to President Ho Chi Minh.

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While the site is viewed from the exterior when closed (Mondays, Fridays, and during maintenance from June to August), its historical importance is palpable. You will then proceed to Tran Quoc Pagoda, one of Hanoi's most ancient Buddhist temples, beautifully situated on West Lake and celebrated for its enduring heritage. The tour concludes with a traditional Vietnamese lunch at a local restaurant, followed by a return to your hotel for an afternoon of independent leisure.
