Day 6

You'll learn about this enduring art form and observe firsthand how these intricate, handmade artworks are meticulously created, providing insight into local artistic heritage.

Continuing your cycling adventure, you'll pedal through quiet village lanes to Thanh Tien Village, a community celebrated for its vibrant paper flowers. From there, the route winds through verdant rice paddies and peaceful rural scenery towards Tien Non Hamlet. This gentle 6 km ride offers the family a wonderful chance to experience a slower, more authentic side of Vietnamese rural life, enjoying the fresh air and serene landscapes. After the cycling portion, you will board a local boat for a relaxing return journey towards Hue.

Following the boat ride, enjoy a satisfying lunch at a local restaurant and take a short break before continuing your journey south. In the afternoon, a private car will transfer you from Hue to Hoi An, a scenic drive of approximately 3 hours. The route passes through beautiful central coast landscapes before arriving at the charming, UNESCO-listed ancient town of Hoi An.

After checking into your hotel, the rest of the day is free for you to relax or explore the enchanting, lantern-lit streets at your own pace. You might also consider an optional Hoi An Motorbike Street Food Tour to sample local culinary delights.

Day 8

Ba Na Hills Mountain Resort & Golden Bridge

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Da Nang | Transport: Car, Cable Car

This morning, between 07:45 and 08:00, your guide will pick you up from your hotel for the drive to Ba Na Hills, a renowned mountain resort celebrated for its refreshing climate, expansive views, and family-friendly attractions. Upon arrival, you'll board the cable car at Suoi Mo Station, embarking on a scenic ride that ascends through lush forested hills, past cascading waterfalls, and into misty mountain landscapes, offering stunning vistas along the way.

Once at the summit, your first stop is the famous Golden Bridge, an architectural marvel and one of Vietnam's most recognizable landmarks. Suspended high above the hills and seemingly held aloft by giant stone hands, it provides an

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incredible setting for family photographs and panoramic views of the surrounding area. Continue your exploration to Jardin D'Amour, a beautifully landscaped garden featuring a variety of flowers, elegant fountains, and themed sections, perfect for a leisurely family stroll. Afterward, enjoy a buffet lunch offering a diverse selection of Vietnamese and international dishes.

The afternoon is dedicated to fun at Fantasy Park, an extensive indoor entertainment complex. At the conclusion of your visit, you'll return via cable car and transfer back to your hotel in Da Nang. Please note that the tour ticket covers round-trip cable car rides and access to major attractions like the Golden Bridge, Fantasy Park, and Moon Castle, but excludes the Wax Museum, Debay Wine Cellar, and certain premium games.

Your city tour commences at the Reunification Palace, a pivotal landmark deeply connected to Vietnam's modern narrative and the reunification of the country. Next, you will visit the War Remnants Museum, which provides a profound and thought-provoking perspective on the Vietnam War through compelling photographs, artifacts, and historical exhibits, offering a powerful educational experience for the family.

The journey continues to two of the city's most iconic colonial-era structures: the grand Saigon Central Post Office, renowned for its architectural beauty, and the impressive Notre Dame Cathedral. Please be aware that the Notre Dame Cathedral is currently closed indefinitely for maintenance. If time permits, a stop at a nearby local market will allow you to soak in the lively atmosphere, browse for souvenirs, or sample a few authentic local snacks, experiencing the city's vibrant daily life. Following the tour, you will be transferred to your hotel to check-in and enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure, perhaps exploring more of the city's culinary scene.

Day 10

Around 07:45, escape the urban energy of Ho Chi Minh City for a full-day adventure to Can Gio, a UNESCO-listed biosphere reserve celebrated for its extensive mangrove forests, diverse wildlife, and scenic riverside landscapes. You'll meet your guide and travel comfortably by air-conditioned vehicle to this unique coastal region situated just outside the bustling city, embarking on a journey into nature.

Your first fascinating stop is Monkey United, a sanctuary home to hundreds of playful long-tailed monkeys that roam freely within the forest. You'll wander through the reserve, enjoying the opportunity to observe these curious creatures up close in their natural habitat. Continue your exploration at the Crocodile Farm, where you can learn about these impressive reptiles and witness their remarkable size and strength, offering an exciting encounter with local fauna. Afterward, board a speedboat for a thrilling ride through the intricate, winding waterways of the Mangrove Forest. Cruise beneath lush green canopies, admiring the untouched beauty of Can Gio National Park, and keep an eye out for local wildlife along the riverbanks.

The journey also includes a visit to a former wartime base, where your guide will share captivating stories and historical insights about the area's significant role during the Vietnam War, providing a deeper understanding of the region's past. At midday, you'll enjoy a delicious lunch at a well-regarded local restaurant, popular for its regional specialties. After lunch, take some time to relax or enjoy the swimming pool before visiting Can Gio Market. Here, you can browse the lively stalls selling fresh produce, seafood, handicrafts, and textiles, with an opportunity to practice your bargaining skills. Before returning to Ho Chi Minh City, you'll receive a special local gift: a tasting of instant bird's nest soup.
