Your local guide will meet you near Hoan Kiem Lake, ready to lead a guided food tour through the vibrant, illuminated streets of the Hanoi Old Quarter. This walking excursion offers a sensory immersion into local life, with enticing aromas and lively sounds at every turn.

The journey takes you through hidden alleys and popular local eateries, providing opportunities to sample Hanoi's most celebrated dishes. You might begin with a comforting bowl of Pho Bo or Bun Thang, or perhaps try Bun Bo Hue, each showcasing Vietnam's rich broth traditions. The exploration continues with savory street favorites such as Banh Cuon, delicate steamed rice rolls filled with pork and mushrooms, and the iconic Banh Mi, a crispy Vietnamese baguette sandwich bursting with flavor. Along the way, you'll nibble on popular street snacks like Nom Bo Kho (dried beef salad) or Nem Chua Ran (crispy fermented pork rolls), beloved by local youth.

The culinary evening concludes on a sweet note with a cup of Ca Phe Trung, Hanoi's specialty egg coffee, known for its creamy texture and rich aroma, served in a cozy local café. Please note that standard hotel check-in time is 14:00; early check-in may incur an additional charge. 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Day 2

Hanoi Cultural Landmarks & Pottery Village Visit

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi

Your morning begins with a pickup from your hotel by the tour leader at 08:00 for a comprehensive exploration of Hanoi's historical and cultural sites. The first stop is the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's inaugural university, showcasing beautifully preserved classical Vietnamese architecture. Next, you will visit the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, a revered national monument of immense historical importance to the Vietnamese people. Please be aware that viewing the Mausoleum is from the outside only, and it is closed on Mondays, Fridays, and from June to August.

The tour continues to the remarkable Tran Quoc Buddhist Pagoda, distinguished by its unique architectural design and profound religious and historical significance. Following this, your family will discover the One Pillar Pagoda, an extraordinary Buddhist structure built on a single stone pillar rising from a lotus pond, symbolizing both cultural and architectural ingenuity. After visiting these significant landmarks, take a leisurely walk around West Lake, immersing yourselves in the tranquil serenity of this expansive freshwater body.

Lunch will be served at an authentic Vietnamese restaurant, offering a taste of local cuisine. The afternoon's destination is Bat Trang Ceramic Village, a traditional porcelain village renowned for its craftsmanship. This location provides engaging activities perfect for family bonding. Here, you'll have the opportunity to learn and try your hand at crafting your own meaningful souvenir. As the sun begins to set, you will return to Hanoi, concluding a day rich in history, culture, and hands-on creativity.

Disembarkation typically occurs around 11:30. Following your cruise experience, you will be transferred to the airport for a domestic flight to Da Nang City. Upon your arrival at Da Nang Airport, a private vehicle will chauffeur you directly to your pre-booked hotel in the charming town of Hoi An. Your morning in Hoi An commences with a visit to Hoi An Market, a lively hub of activity that offers a truly memorable shopping experience filled with vibrant sights, sounds, and aromas. Just a short distance away lies the Fujian Assembly Hall, a colorful architectural marvel blending ornate gates, intricate dragon sculptures, and distinctive rooftops. Here, you'll gain insights into ancestor worship, observe the family altar, and witness locals making their traditional offerings.

Continue your exploration to some of Hoi An's remarkably preserved ancient houses, such as the Phung Hung Ancient House or Tan Ky Ancient House, both standing resilient after more than two centuries of history and weather. Afterward, head to the Museum of Folk Culture, housed within a 150-year-old Chinese merchant house, where a curated collection of artifacts vividly portrays the traditional daily life of the region. You'll also have the opportunity to enjoy traditional performances at the Hoi An Traditional Performing Arts House.

A mandatory stop is the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge, which spans a small canal and was constructed over 400 years ago to connect the Japanese and Chinese communities. To complete your experience, explore some of Hoi An's famed handicraft shops and art galleries, and wander through charming alleyways and local neighborhoods to fully appreciate the timeless allure of this ancient town. The day provides a deep dive into Hoi An's rich history and vibrant culture.

Day 7**Ba Na Hills Excursion & Golden Bridge Discovery**

Our guide and driver will pick you up directly from your hotel to begin a scenic drive towards the stunning Ba Na Hills. This renowned hilltop resort is celebrated for its cool climate and distinctive French-inspired architecture. Upon arrival, you'll check in at the Suoi Mo Cable Car Station and board one of the world's longest non-stop cable cars. As you ascend, take in breathtaking panoramic views of lush mountains, dense forests, and cascading waterfalls below, setting the stage for an extraordinary day.

Your first stop at the top is Marseille Station, which serves as the gateway to Ba Na's most iconic sights. From there, you'll walk to the breathtaking Golden Bridge, a stunning architectural marvel seemingly held aloft by two massive stone hands. This is an ideal spot to capture incredible photos and enjoy sweeping views of the verdant surroundings. Next, take a tranquil stroll through Jardin D'Amour, a collection of exquisitely themed gardens filled with vibrant blooms, playful sculptures, and romantic European-style landscaping, perfect for a leisurely walk.

For lunch, indulge in a flavorful Vietnamese buffet featuring more than 70 local dishes. This extensive culinary spread highlights regional delicacies and seasonal flavors, ensuring there is something to satisfy every palate. After lunch, the adventure continues at Fantasy Park, an indoor amusement park offering a wide range of activities – from 4D cinemas and arcade games to thrilling rides and a dinosaur museum. Later in the afternoon, ascend to King Peak, the highest point of Ba Na Hills at 1,487 meters above sea level. From this vantage point, soak in sweeping 360-degree views and admire the pagodas and peaceful temples that crown the mountaintop. Conclude your visit by returning to the cable car station for a final scenic ride down the mountain. Our guide will then escort you back to your hotel, bringing a memorable day to a close. Note that the tour price includes round-trip cable car, entrance fees to key attractions (Golden Bridge, Fantasy Park, King Peak, Moon Castle), and lunch, while certain attractions like the Wax Museum, Debay Wine Cellar, and specific games may incur additional charges.
