Day 2

Following your river adventure, a delicious lunch featuring local specialties will be served at a nearby restaurant. The afternoon

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is dedicated to exploring Hoa Lu, Vietnam's ancient capital, which boasts a rich history spanning over a millennium. Visit the revered temples dedicated to King Dinh and King Le, crossing the designated bridge to explore these significant historical sites. Next, explore some of Hoi An's remarkably preserved ancient houses, such as Phung Hung and Tan Ky, both over two centuries old, providing insights into traditional family life and architecture. Continue to the Museum of Folk Culture, housed in a 150-year-old former Chinese merchant residence, where artifacts vividly illustrate Hoi An's past. You'll also witness traditional art performances at the Hoi An Traditional Performing Arts House. The tour includes a stop at the historic Japanese Covered Bridge, a 400-year-old landmark connecting the former Japanese and Chinese communities. Conclude your exploration by wandering through charming craft shops, art galleries, and hidden alleyways, uncovering the unique character of this ancient town.

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Between 7:45 AM and 8:00 AM, you will be picked up from your Hoi An hotel for a scenic transfer to the spectacular Ba Na Hills. Upon arrival, check in at the Suoi Mo Cable Car Station, where you will board a cable car to Marseille Station. This ascent offers breathtaking panoramic views of the surrounding mountains and lush landscapes. Once at Ba Na Hills, your exploration begins with several key attractions.

A highlight is the renowned Golden Bridge, an architectural marvel supported by two enormous stone hands, providing stunning vistas of the hills and forests. Continue to the beautiful Jardin D'Amour, a series of themed gardens featuring fountains, sculptures, and vibrant floral displays. Your next stop is the Linh Ung Pagoda, a significant Buddhist shrine known for its magnificent statue. Enjoy a delicious Vietnamese buffet lunch at a local restaurant, offering a wide selection of dishes with excellent views. The afternoon is dedicated to Fantasy Park, an amusement park filled with various rides, games, and attractions suitable for all ages. At 8:00 AM, depart from Ho Chi Minh City for a journey to My Tho, a charming village situated on the left bank of the Mekong River. Your first stop will be the Vinh Trang Pagoda, a renowned 19th-century Buddhist temple in Tien Giang province, known for its unique architectural blend of Vietnamese, Khmer, and French influences. Following this cultural visit, you will board a sampan for a scenic river cruise, navigating the tranquil waters of the Mekong. The journey includes stops at several enticing islands, famously named Dragon, Unicorn, Phoenix, and Tortoise Islands, each offering a glimpse into local life. On Unicorn Island, you'll have the opportunity to explore lush orchards, sample exotic seasonal fruits, and enjoy traditional Vietnamese folk music performed by local musicians. Continue your adventure with a serene hand-rowed sampan ride through the narrow Thoi Son canal, soaking in the picturesque scenery of the delta. A traditional lunch will be served at a local eatery, providing an authentic taste of the region. In the afternoon, explore Tan Thach Village by bicycle, gaining a deeper understanding of the daily routines and tranquil lifestyle of the Mekong Delta inhabitants before returning to Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 9

Cu Chi Tunnels Historical Insight

At 8:00 AM, depart from Ho Chi Minh City for a two-hour transfer to the historic Cu Chi Tunnels. The journey offers a chance to observe the tranquil countryside scenery outside the bustling city. Upon arrival at this significant historical site, you will gain profound insights into the Vietnam War through a series of engaging activities. Begin by watching a documentary film that details the construction and strategic use of these underground tunnels during the conflict, providing context to their importance. Experience a taste of the wartime diet by sampling hot tea, tapioca, and rice, which were staple rations for local soldiers. For those interested, there is an optional opportunity to visit a local firing range and try shooting historical firearms like an AK-47 or M16 (at an additional cost). This provides a visceral understanding of the conditions faced by soldiers. The tour concludes around 1:00 PM with your transfer back to Ho Chi Minh City, leaving the rest of the afternoon free for independent exploration

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or relaxation.
