Day 1 Ho Chi Minh City Arrival & Leisure

Day 2 Cao Dai Temple & Cu Chi Tunnels Exploration

Following breakfast, your day begins with a road journey to Tay Ninh province. Here, you will visit the distinctive Cao Dai

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Temple, an architectural marvel known for its unique blend of religious symbols. You'll have the opportunity to observe the fascinating mid-day service, where followers in colorful robes participate in a ceremony that reflects the syncretic nature of Cao Daiism, incorporating elements of Confucianism, Taoism, and Buddhism.

After this cultural experience, the tour continues to the historically significant Cu Chi Tunnels. This extensive underground network was ingeniously constructed by Vietnamese resistance fighters during their struggle for independence. Gain insight into the challenging conditions faced by soldiers as you explore sections of the tunnels, which once housed hospitals, living quarters, and schools, serving as a crucial military base during the American War. The day concludes with your return to Ho Chi Minh City for an overnight stay.

Day 3**Mekong Delta River Life & Local Crafts**

Today's journey takes you to My Tho province, the gateway to the Mekong Delta. Upon arrival, you will board a boat for a scenic cruise through the region's intricate network of small canals. This offers an excellent vantage point to observe the daily life of local communities and admire the numerous islands dotting the delta. The boat excursion will pass through lush green landscapes before reaching the renowned Unicorn Island. Here, you'll disembark to wander through an orchard, sampling a variety of fresh seasonal fruits while enjoying traditional Vietnamese music performances.

The adventure continues with a visit to Ben Tre Province, where you'll discover local industries and craft workshops, gaining insight into traditional production methods. A substantial lunch will be served, providing a taste of regional specialties. In the afternoon, you will journey back to Ho Chi Minh City. Along the way, stops include the beautiful Vinh Trang Pagoda, a prominent Buddhist temple, and Cho Lon, Saigon's historic Chinatown, characterized by its sacred temples and winding, narrow streets. You will spend the night back in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 4**Ho Chi Minh City Sights & Flight to Hoi An**

Begin your day with a half-day city tour of Ho Chi Minh. Your first stop is the Reunification Palace, the former residence of the President of South Vietnam until April 1975, offering a glimpse into a pivotal moment in the nation's history. You will also see significant French colonial architecture, including the impressive Notre Dame Cathedral and the historic Old Saigon Post Office.

The tour continues with a visit to the Jade Emperor Pagoda, a beautifully adorned Taoist temple, followed by the War Remnants Museum, which provides a powerful and moving perspective on the Vietnam War. Conclude your city exploration at the bustling Ben Thanh Market, where a wide array of goods, from souvenirs to local foods, is available. Later, you will be transferred to the airport for a domestic flight to Da Nang. Upon arrival in Da Nang, you will be met by a driver and transferred directly to Hoi An, a charming town with a rich history as a Cham seaport, influenced by centuries of international trade. Settle into your accommodation for the night in Hoi An.

Day 5**Ancient Hoi An & Scenic Drive to Hue***Meals: B,D | Stay: Hue | Transport: Private vehicle*

This morning, embark on a walking tour to explore the ancient town of Hoi An, a UNESCO World Heritage site. This delightful and peaceful town showcases a captivating blend of Vietnamese traditions with Chinese and Japanese architectural influences. Highlights of your visit include the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge, the Pottery Museum, the remarkably preserved 200-year-old Tam Ky House, the Chua Ong Pagoda, and the lively local market. As you stroll through the narrow streets, you'll observe numerous low tiled houses and assembly halls, all reflecting the town's diverse multicultural past.

In the afternoon, you will drive north to Hue, Vietnam's last imperial capital. The journey itself is scenic, with planned stops along the way. Your first stop will be the sensational Marble Mountains, a cluster of five limestone and marble hills. You'll also pause at China Beach, known for its long sandy shores, and visit Da Nang City to explore the Cham Museum, housing a significant collection of Cham sculpture. The road then ascends over the breathtaking Hai Van Pass, offering panoramic views of the coastline, before descending into Hue, where you will spend the night.

After breakfast, embark on a serene boat cruise upstream on the Perfume River. This journey provides a peaceful view of the surrounding countryside and leads you to the beautiful Thien Mu Pagoda, an iconic symbol of Hue. After exploring this historic pagoda, the cruise continues to the mausoleum of Emperor Minh Mang, set within a tranquil landscape of gardens and lakes, offering a glimpse into imperial burial traditions.

Your next stops include the elaborate royal tomb of Emperor Tu Duc, another significant imperial resting place, and the famous Tu Hieu Pagoda. Upon returning to the city center, you'll take a leisurely walk through the bustling Dong Ba Market. This vibrant market offers a chance to observe local commerce and discover various fantastic eating spots, where you can sample some of Hue's renowned local delicacies. The day concludes with an overnight stay in Hue.

Later, you will be transferred to the airport for a flight to Hanoi. Upon your arrival in Hanoi, your tour guide and driver will be waiting to pick you up.

From Hanoi, you will embark on a scenic three-and-a-half-hour drive to Halong, home to one of Vietnam's most impressive natural landscapes. The journey provides chances to stop as desired, allowing you to stretch your legs and capture photographs of the passing scenery. You will arrive in Halong in the late afternoon or early evening, where you will check into your accommodation for an overnight stay, preparing for your bay exploration the following day.

Departing from the town, your boat will navigate through a breathtaking landscape where the sky meets the emerald waters, dotted with approximately 3,000 towering limestone islands. These dramatic karst formations are adorned with secluded beaches, hidden grottoes, and stunning caves. During the cruise, the boat will anchor in a secluded cove, providing an opportunity for a leisurely swim in the clear waters. You will also enjoy a visit to one of the many hidden grottoes nestled beneath the towering cliffs, exploring its unique geological features. A fresh seafood lunch will be served onboard, allowing you to savor local flavors amidst the stunning scenery. In the afternoon, you will return to Hanoi, making a stop en route at the Dong Trieu pottery village to observe traditional craftsmanship. You will spend the night in Hanoi.

The tour continues to the Temple of Literature, recognized as Vietnam's first national university, offering a serene glimpse into ancient scholarship. Next, explore the impressive Ethnologic Museum, which provides comprehensive insights into Vietnam's 54 diverse ethnic groups. You will also see the beautiful West Lake and visit the History Museum, housing an excellent collection of artifacts that illustrate Vietnamese history. Conclude your day at the peaceful Hoan Kiem Lake, where you will attend a fantastic traditional water puppet theatre performance, a unique form of Vietnamese art. You will spend the night in Hanoi.
