Following a brief stop for breakfast, the group will proceed to Cho Moi Commune, home to the century-old My An Wicker Village.

This traditional village has been dedicated to crafting exquisite hand-woven wicker goods for over a century. You'll have the opportunity to walk among local artisans, observing as they skillfully transform bamboo and rattan into intricately designed baskets, trays, and various household items. Witness firsthand how cultural pride and expert hands shape each piece, sustaining a craft deeply rooted in the Mekong region's soul. Continue your journey to the nearby Hoi An Leaf Hat Craft Village – distinct from the town of Hoi An. This quiet yet historically rich village, dating back to the 1930s, has long specialized in crafting "non la," Vietnam's iconic conical hats. You'll gain a rare insight into how these timeless symbols are made, with layers of palm leaves delicately sewn into shape, each hat embodying a graceful blend of function, history, and Vietnamese identity. From there, the car continues towards Long Xuyen, a charming riverside city in An Giang. You'll experience a quintessential Mekong moment by crossing the Hau River via the An Hoa Ferry. The Hau River, one of the Mekong's "Nine Dragons," carries the legacy of generations. As you drift across on this humble yet vital ferry, you'll feel the pulse of the Delta, where water serves as both a thoroughfare and a source of livelihood. Upon reaching Phan Nam Farm, you'll dive into hands-on rural life. At this eco-friendly farm, roll up your sleeves and join locals in the joyful, muddy, and quintessentially Vietnamese experience of catching fish from a pond. Afterward, explore the farm's organic vegetable and fruit gardens, cultivated using clean, sustainable methods.
