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Next, discover the unique and fascinating art of hammock weaving using banana rope, and even try weaving a section yourself under the guidance of a local expert. Continue to a welcoming village home, where you will explore the craft of water hyacinth weaving, a sustainable practice that transforms a common plant into beautiful, eco-friendly baskets, mats, and accessories. Under your host's careful instruction, create your own small souvenir to take home. Then, learn about the intricate art of crafting bamboo nail files, a clever example of how local communities creatively utilize available natural materials. The morning concludes with a delightful cooking activity focused on jackfruit leaf cakes, a traditional Mekong treat known for its soft, chewy texture and subtly sweet flavor. As you prepare the cakes with your host, you will not only learn the recipe but also enjoy the fruits of your labor in a light, homemade tasting session. At 12:00, bid farewell to the gentle rhythms of Tan Phong Island and board the ferry to Hiep Duc, where your transfer awaits. This remarkable community is built upon towering stilts, ranging from 8 to 10 meters high, rising dramatically above the floodwaters of Tonle Sap Lake. Tonle Sap is Southeast Asia's largest freshwater lake and one of the region's richest ecosystems. Upon arrival, you will board a traditional wooden boat and glide slowly through the labyrinth of stilted homes, where daily life unfolds above the water.

As you cruise deeper into the flooded mangrove forests, observe the tranquility of nature and listen for the calls of water birds that thrive in this lush habitat. The area supports over a hundred species of freshwater fish and countless birds, making it a vital sanctuary for both people and wildlife. After the cruise, return to Siem Reap for a brief rest at your hotel. In the evening, gather for a vibrant dinner show, where classical Apsara dancers, adorned in ornate silk costumes, perform graceful movements that recount ancient stories of love, legends, and Khmer heritage. Savor a flavorful meal of Cambodian delicacies as music and dance bring the culture of the kingdom to life, providing an unforgettable farewell to your Southeast Asia journey.

Activities: Drive to Kompong Phluk floating village.
Take a traditional wooden boat cruise through the stilted village.
Explore the flooded mangrove forests.
Return to Siem Reap.
Attend a Cambodian dinner show with Apsara dancers.
