Day 14**Ho Chi Minh City's Hidden Gems and Historical Insights**

As the day unfolds, explore Saigon's architectural and historical treasures that reveal its complex past. Marvel at the elegant Saigon Notre Dame Cathedral, a French colonial masterpiece built with imported red bricks and flanked by twin spires (note: currently under renovation).
