Day 7**My Son Sanctuary & Hoi An Ancient Town**

Today's itinerary begins with an excursion to My Son Sanctuary, a UNESCO World Heritage site located approximately 40

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kilometers southwest of Hoi An. This historically significant site was once the capital and religious center of the Cham people, who flourished in the region from the 4th to the 13th centuries. You will explore the impressive remnants of red brick towers and sanctuaries, which stand as a testament to the sophisticated Cham civilization. My Son is often compared to other great archaeological sites in Southeast Asia, such as Angkor Wat in Cambodia and Bagan in Myanmar, for its architectural and historical importance.

These ancient towers and sanctuaries, constructed between the 7th and 13th centuries, offer a fascinating glimpse into the spiritual and artistic achievements of the Cham kingdom. A guided tour of the site will provide context on the religious practices and architectural styles prevalent during that era. After immersing yourself in the historical grandeur of My Son, you will return to Hoi An for lunch at a local restaurant, savoring regional flavors.

In the afternoon, the focus shifts to the tranquility and charm of Hoi An Ancient Town. This beautifully preserved trading port, also a UNESCO World Heritage site, captivates visitors with its low-tiled houses, distinct Chinese architectural influences, and brightly painted temples and pagodas. The town's vibrant atmosphere, enhanced by numerous tailor shops and artisan workshops, makes it one of Vietnam's most delightful destinations. Your day concludes with an overnight stay in Hoi An.

This morning, you will transfer from your hotel in Hoi An to Da Nang airport for a short domestic flight to Ho Chi Minh City, often referred to as Saigon. Upon arrival at Ho Chi Minh City, a vehicle will be waiting to take you directly to the Cu Chi Tunnels. This historical site offers a profound insight into Vietnam's wartime past and the ingenuity of the Viet Cong soldiers.

The Cu Chi Tunnels were an integral part of an extensive underground network, meticulously constructed by the Viet Cong during the American War. This complex system stretched from the southern tip of the Ho Chi Minh trail near the Cambodian border all the way to the Saigon River. During your visit, you will have the unique opportunity to creep into a section of the tunnels, experiencing firsthand the incredibly cramped and challenging conditions in which the Viet Cong lived, worked, and fought.

After exploring the tunnels and learning about their historical significance, you will return to the city center of Ho Chi Minh. The afternoon continues with a tour of the city's prominent landmarks.
