Day 14**Da Lat Waterfalls & Local Craft Exploration***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Da Lat*

Your full-day tour begins with a hotel pick-up between 08:15 and 08:30. The first destination at 09:00 is Datanla Waterfall, one of the most accessible and picturesque waterfalls near Da Lat. Surrounded by lush jungle, this 25-meter cascade gently flows over rock shelves into the area known as "Death Valley." You can choose to walk to its base or opt for an exhilarating roller coaster ride (optional, at your own expense).

At 10:00, visit Chicken Village, a small K'Ho ethnic minority settlement, notable for its large concrete chicken statue. Here, you can observe local women crafting traditional scarves, bags, and other handicrafts. Next, at 10:30, stop at a pepper farm to learn about the cultivation of this popular spice. By 11:00, arrive at Pongour Waterfall, considered one of the Central Highlands' most majestic waterfalls, cascading 40 meters high and over 100 meters wide across multiple sandstone steps amidst untouched forest. Around 12:00, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, with recommendations available from your guide.

The afternoon continues at 13:00 with an exploration of Elephant Waterfall, standing 35 meters high and 40 meters wide, making it Lam Dong's second widest.
